Dear RMES Parents & Guardians,

The following are pertinent reminders and updates for this week and, in the near future. Please read and apply the information as needed.

Solar Eclipse Day: Tomorrow, Monday, April 8 between approximately 2:00-4:00 p.m. will be the long anticipated solar eclipse event. As you already know viewers in Berrien Springs will see a partial eclipse (about 95%) at approximately 3:08pm. Recognizing that this will be around the end of the school day, please be aware that, weather permitting, we will be taking the K-6 students outside to watch the eclipse. You are invited to join our K-6 and your child to witness this once in a lifetime experience, for many. I shared last week that ISO certified glasses have been provided for all RMES students and staff members by the Chemistry Department. I would like to make one correction—the eclipse viewing glasses were provided by our thoughtful and generous partners at AU Physics (not chemistry) Department. Thank you, Dr. Cross and Kelly, on behalf of RMES faculty, staff and students. Wishing everyone a safe and happy eclipse viewing!

Solar Eclipse Day Dismissal Procedure: Recognizing that the eclipse viewing time is close to dismissal (3:08pm), please be aware that the K-6 students and teachers may be delayed returning in the classroom for the regular dismissal routine. However, know that we will do our best to have your child/ren ready for pick-up between 3:300-3:45pm. Due to the key dismissal traffic personnel being out with the 7th & 8th grade Eclipse Field Trip, we also request your patience and understanding due to reduced help with the dismissal procedure tomorrow. Thank you in advance for your cooperation and support.
